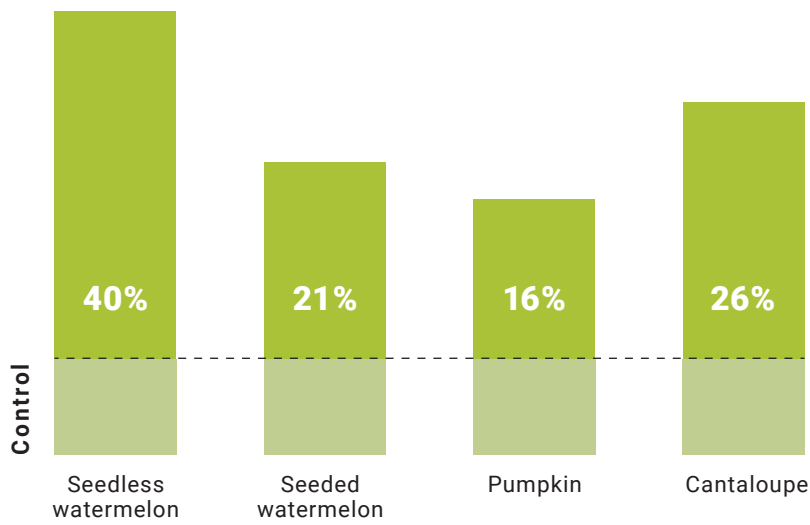

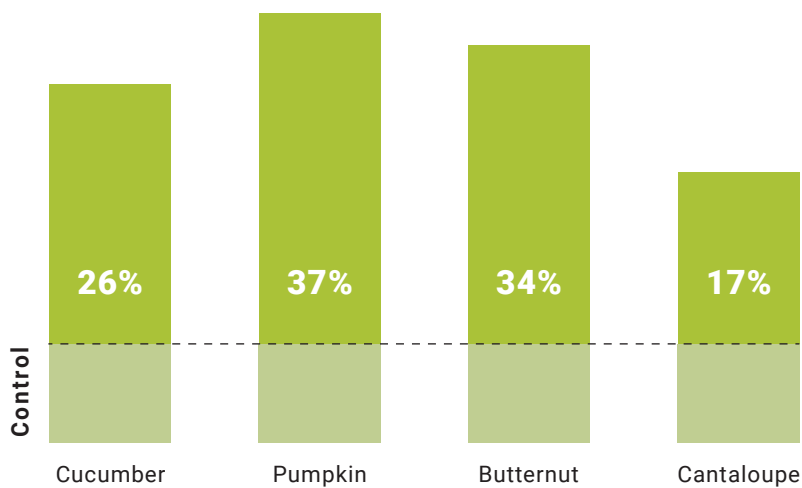

Recommended application rate

Transplants: Dip the seedlings in seedling tray in 1% Kelpak or water trays directly before transplanting

Follow up with a 2 to 3 pts/Ac Kelpak foliar spray 14 days later and repeat the foliar spray 14–21 days later

Direct seeding: Apply as a foliar spray at 2 to 3 pts/Ac at the 3 to 4-leaf stage and repeat the foliar application twice at 14 day intervals

The use of a standard surfactant is recommended, while the pH of the spray solution should be below 7
